We will also accept complete yarn balls as long as they have their original labels and no smell of smoke, pets, mildew, or mothballs.

Needles will be accepted, if like new. (Don't dump your junk on your guild!)

Time to clear them out. Your "trash" is someone else's "treasure!"

Be sure to bring something to keep you busy while others are shopping. When it's over, you may take your items back or leave them as a donation to the guild. We will have a "second chance sale" for those who cannot attend this month's meeting, then the rest will be donated to charity.
