Program: Single-Color Brioche Knitting

Instructor: Anna-Sophia Z.

This program will provide an introduction to single-color brioche knitting, including an overview of its characteristics and the variations that can be achieved with brioche. We'll start out gently with flat brioche using the "brk" and, if time permits, I'll touch on brioche in the round and introduce the "brp."

Supplies and Materials: A yarn and corresponding needles, nothing super fine or too textured. I would suggest circular needles rather than DPNs. Straight needles are also fine if they don't want to worry about trying out in the round.
