## Program: Concealing Color Changes without Cutting & Splicing Yarn Instructor: Margot F.

Learn how to alternate stripes of different yarn colors, without having to cut and splice yarn at color changes, by using i-cord.

Material and Supplies: Two colors of yarn and suitable size needles.

Homework: Cast on 18 stitches. Begin each row with 3 purl stitches, and then knit the remaining 15 stitches to the end of each row. Knit (in one color) until you have at least 6 rows. The resulting swatch will be mostly garter stitch, with a column of stockinette stitch on the left edge, and a column of reverse stockinette on the right edge.
